



Termes Castle

A wide footpath overlooking the village, forests and spectacular gorges, with an easy access to the castle ruins in just 1.5 minutes, with partial access for pushchairs. Use the visitor materials to imagine what the castle and castrum once looked like. You can find out about the epic resistance against the crusaders in 1210 and the massive building project that made Termes «one of the 5 sons of Carcassonne». The Termes Castle site is regularly excavated by archaeologists and restored by qualified masons. Visitors can explore a little more at each visit.
